Quick Facts: Health Hazards of Common Carpet Stain Removers

- **Perchloroethylene:** Perc is a recognized human carcinogen and can lead to side effects like dizziness, fatigue, and headaches.
- **Naphthalene:** When exposed to this chemical, humans can experience decreased red blood cell count and eventual anemia.
- **Formaldehyde:** This ubiquitous chemical is a known cancer-causer in high amounts for prolonged periods, and in short exposures, causes throat, nose, and eye burning and wheezing.

DIY Green Cleaning Recipes for Carpet Stain Remover

1. **Vinegar and water natural carpet stain remover:** Mix equal parts white vinegar and water in a spray bottle and shake gently. Spray on spots, let soak a few minutes, and then scrub with a brush to complete stain removal. Rinse with water when finished and blot to dry.

2. **Heavy duty carpet stain remover:** Mix 1/4 cup each of vinegar, salt, and borax to form a carpet cleaning paste. Rub the paste into carpet, using a brush if necessary. Allow to dry completely and then vacuum thoroughly

3. **Vinegar and baking soda paste carpet stain remover:** Form a paste by combining 1/2 cup white vinegar, 1/2 cup baking soda, and 1/4 cup water. Scrub the paste into carpet, and then vacuum when dry.

4. Castile carpet stain remover: Mix one teaspoon of liquid castile soap with one cup of warm water. Scrub stains, and then blot to dry with a dry cloth.

5. **Castile soap and borax carpet stain remover:** In a container, mix one cup of liquid castile soap with one cup of borax and mix. Apply to stains, scrub, and vacuum remnants when dry.
